Can you tell us about some of your live/studio experience highlights or current activities?

I have been working in the Melbourne entertainment scene for around 20 years. Currently I am working with a cover band called "Adam 12" who are doing 3 to 4 shows a week. I also have an original band called "Welcome to the Numb", we are in the process of releasing a new EP which we recorded with producer Peter Reggie Bowman. Aside from working with other cover and original acts, I also do studio session work, which can range from punk rock to movie soundtracks.





Have you had any previous experiences with the brand Warwick?

My previous experience with Warwick as a brand has been limited to bass players that I have played with over the years, I've always loved how their bass gear sounds.
